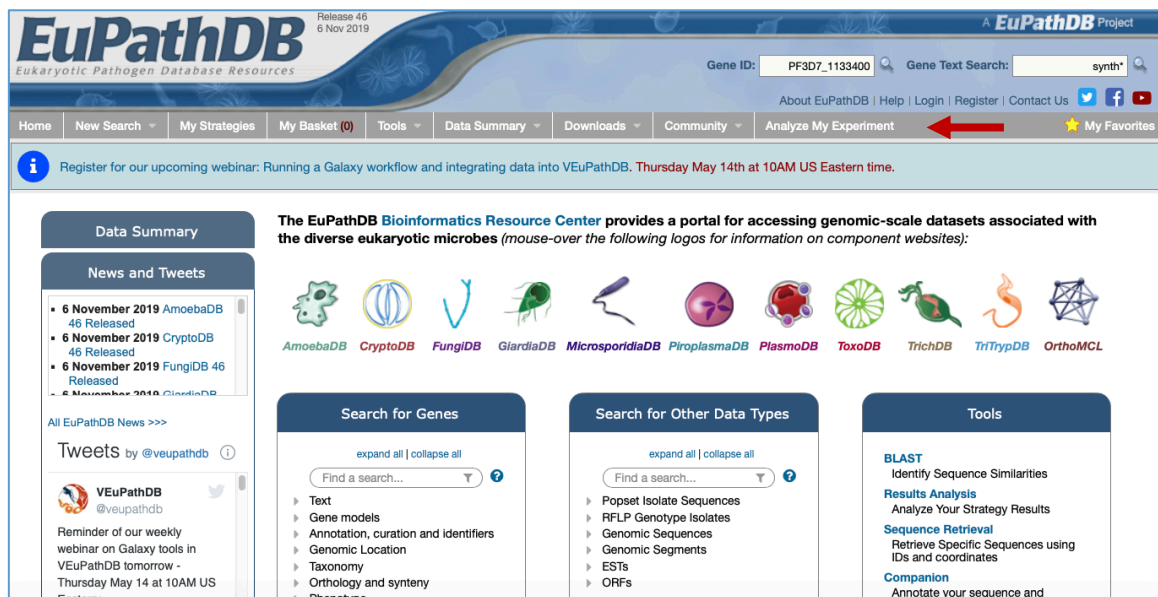


Setting up a VEuPathDB Galaxy account

Galaxy is an open, web-based platform for data-intensive biomedical research. Galaxy allows you to perform, reproduce, and share complete analyses without the use of command-line scripting. The EuPathDB project, now known as VEuPathDB, developed its Galaxy instance in collaboration with Globus Genomics. VEuPathDB Galaxy can be accessed from any VEuPathDB site by navigating to the “Analyze My Experiment” tab.

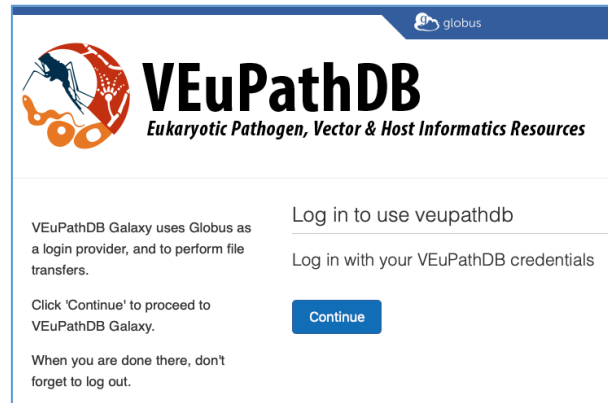

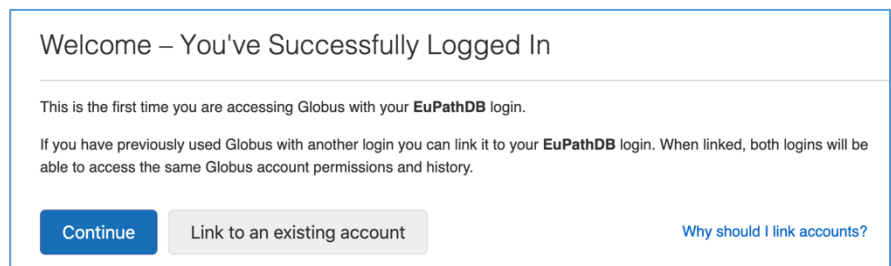
Step 1: If you do not have an account, you will need to create one. To create a free account, click on “Register” at the top right corner of any VEuPathDB site and follow instructions. If you already have an account, proceed to Step 2.

Step 2: Access the VEuPathDB Galaxy instance at the following URL:

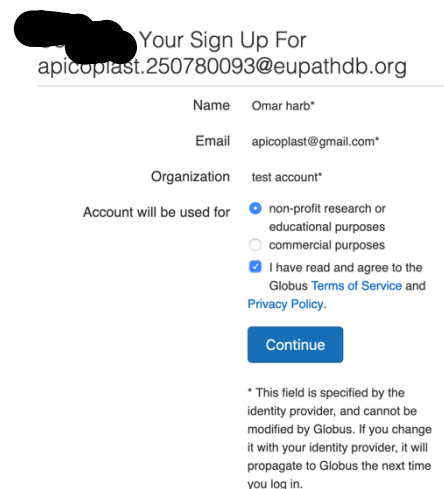
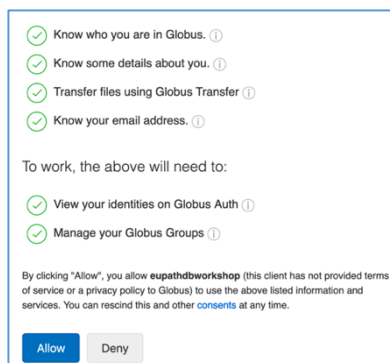
Step 3: Log in to your account:

Step 5: on the next window select the “non-profit” option and agree to the Terms of Service. Click continue.

Step 6: The next page will ask for permissions required to use this Galaxy instance. Click on “Allow”
